

Great Performances for the Mississauga Aquatic Club at Nothers!

Congratulations MSSAC swimmers on your great performances in London. The Mississauga Aquatic Club performed extremely well in the Nothers meet in London this past weekend. This meet represented a great opportunity for many of our swimmers to get up make finals, get medals, and win. In addition to a great racing opportunity the club bonding was great.

Saturday Afternoon the 12&under MSSAC swimmers won 9 gold medals, 10 silver and 8 bronze. This was a great session. Gold Medal winners included Victor Truong, Yasha Sinitski, Chinmay Patil, Alyssa Bellio, Abdullah Ahmad, Alexandra Jozwiak, Megan Vuong, and Stephanie Ly. Silver medal winners were Vasha Sinitski, Laura Johnston, Victor Truong, Isaac Crowe, Julia Matuszczak, Rodrigo Villalobos, Alyssa Bellio, Alexandra Jozwiak, and Victoria Gardiner.

On Saturday night the goal was to come away from the finals session with 35 medals. The team stepped up and performed. Leading the charge were some of our usual top performers but there were some new names contributing to the medal total. Michael Decsey won four gold medals on the first night in the 200IM, 100 free, 200 fly, and 400 free. Deniz Selcuk stepped into a great 200 fly winning gold. Taylor Anderson won gold in the 100 breast, silver in the 200 back, and bronze in the 100 free. Eric Xiao won silver in the 100 free, and Maxwell Fu won silver in the 100 breast. Daniela Gray came from an outside lane to steal a medal in the 100 breast.

The medal total on the Saturday night was 18 gold, 13 silver, and 5 bronze, beating our goal of 35 medals, and bringing our total medal count to 27 gold, 23 silver, and 13 bronze.

Sunday was more of the same with many swimmers performing at their lifetime best. Mississauga Aquatic Club added 22 gold, 19 silver, and 18 bronze medals to the total bringing the final count up to 49 gold, 42 silver, and 31 bronze, an outstanding meet. The performances again were great on Sunday and we continued to see new faces in the finals, placing in the top 3, and winning. Jami Dewaele-Kynkal won a gold and two bronze, Victor Truong won gold and silver. Taylor Anderson won gold and two silver. Lauren Mokry won two bronze. The 14 year old girls won first, second, third, and fourth in the 400 IM with Nicolette Goncalves, Janica Lee, Olivia Bellio, and Paolina Carnevale. Emilia Henriques won bronze in the 200 breast.
